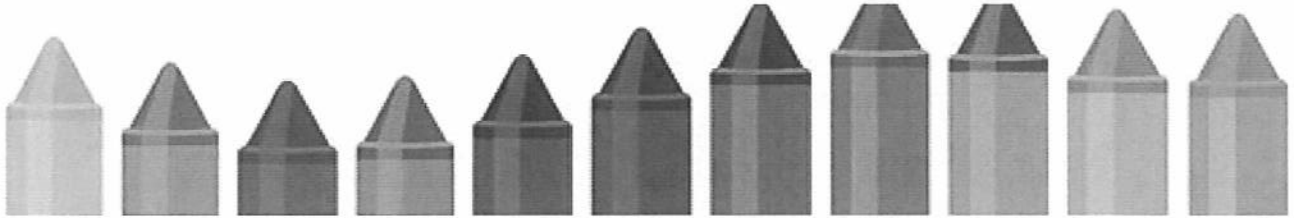

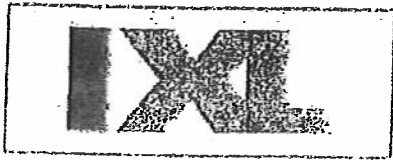

I am pleased to tell you that we will be using a website called IXL in our classroom this year. IXL is a comprehensive learning program offering unlimited math and language arts practice across thousands of skills—all of which are aligned to Florida Standards. One of the best things about IXL is that your child can access it from home, so you have a chance to see your child's progress!

To get your child started on your home computer, please follow these easy steps:

1. Go to <https://www.ixl.com/signin/hrsr>
2. Enter your child's username and password and click "Sign in."
3. Click on any skill to start learning!

IXL is designed to help your child learn at his or her own pace. The program is adaptive and will adjust based on your child's demonstrated understanding of the material. All of your child's results will be saved, so you can monitor his or her progress anytime by clicking on Analytics. For on-the-go practice, you can download IXL's free tablet apps for iPad, Android, or Kindle and sign in with your child's username and password.

I hope you'll encourage your son or daughter to use IXL regularly. Here's to a year of working together to make learning fun for your child!

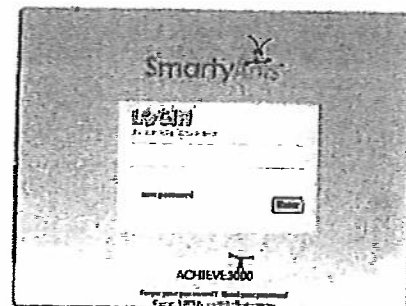

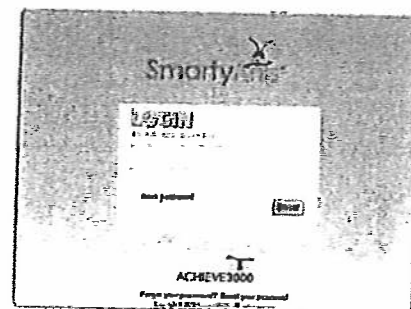

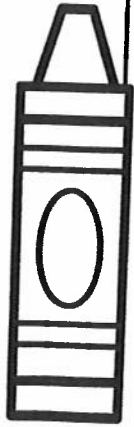
1. The Sign of the Cross In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

## Sight Words

Sight words (sometimes called high-frequency words) are words that cannot be “sounded out” phonetically and are taught to students as a whole by sight. Learning sight words should be done once students have a good amount of letters and sounds mastered. When learning sight words, have your student practice spelling the word when reading it. The words included in this packet are some of the first words your student will learn in pre-k 4 and will help them when beginning to read and write sentences.
