One of the best things about IXL is that your child can access it from home, so you have a chance to see your child's progress!

To get your child started on your home computer, please follow these easy steps:

IXL is designed to help your child learn at his or her own pace. The program is adaptive and will adjust based on your child's demonstrated understanding of the material. Sight Words

Sight words (sometimes called high-frequency words) are words that cannot be "sounded out" phonetically and are taught to students as a whole by sight. Learning sight words should be done once students have a good amount of letters and sounds mastered. When learning sight words, have your student practice spelling the word when reading it. The words included in this packet are some of the first words your student will learn in pre-k 4 and will help them when beginning to read and write sentences.
